Dr. Stefanie Leiterholt has been President Human Resources & Legal at WMF GmbH since 2011 and is responsible, among other tasks, for human resources at the long-established company. Previously, she was responsible for this topic in various technology companies.

Dr. Stefan Wolf was CEO of automotive supplier Elring-Klinger for 17 years, until the end of June this year. He has also been President of Gesamtmetall since 2020 - and in this role represents German employers in the electrical and metal industry with almost four million employees.

Jutta Balletshofer looks after HR strategies at Organon Healthcare as Executive Director and HR Lead Europe and Canada. The pharmaceutical company with a focus on women's health employs around 10,000 people worldwide.

Roland Hehn has been Chief Human Resources Officer at Schwarz Dienstleistungen for just over a year. The Schwarz Group employs 575,000 people worldwide.

Angela Todisco is Head of Human Resources EMEA North at SAP, responsible for human resources strategy in seven European countries.

Albert Berger, Chancellor of the Technical University of Munich since 2006, is the host of the fourth TUM TALK. The lawyer was the federal spokesperson for the chancellors of Germany's universities for several years and has been a member of the University Advisory Board of the Munich School of Public Policy since 2015.

Professor Dr. Helmut Krcmar is Professor of Information Systems and was Vice Dean of the TUM School of Management. He is also the founding dean and the president's representative for the TUM Campus Heilbronn. He moderates the TUM TALK.
